REPEAL OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 15-03

WHEREAS, the threat to the health, safety and resources of the people of the State presented by heavy snow accumulations, drifting snow and high winds during the snowstorm has abated to a sufficient degree to lift the legal restrictions on motor vehicle travel.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GINA M. RAIMONDO, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations, pursuant to Article IX of the Rhode Island Constitution and the Rhode Island General Laws, including, but not limited to, Title 30, Chapter 15, do hereby order and direct the following:

- 1. Executive Order 15-03, "Restriction on Motor Vehicle Travel," is repealed, effective at 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 27, 2015.
- 2. Rhode Islanders are strongly encouraged to avoid travel until the morning of Wednesday, January 28, 2015, to allow snowplowing and road-clearing operations to continue.
